<p><b>ELA Goal:</b> By the end of the year, the average of fourth and fifth grade students maintaining or increasing to a Basic or above will increase from 69% to 74%.</p> <p><b>MATH Goal:</b> By the end of the year, the average of fourth and fifth grade students maintaining or increasing to a Basic or above will increase from 71% to 76%.</p> <p><b>Subgroup Goal:</b> By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, all subgroups will make adequate progress toward mastery of the state standards; therefore removing labels of "Urgent Intervention Needed or Required."</p>

<b>Schoolwide Strategies:</b> High quality curriculum and assessments in all grades, high quality planning, high quality professional development for all teachers, and building school-based expertise through leadership roles; Response to Intervention with on-grade level skills, as well as filling in gaps in knowledge in small groups for reading and math skills; increasing student engagement during instruction; classroom observations and feedback to teachers

<b>NON-ACADEMIC Goal:</b> By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, the number of major infractions will decrease from 115 to 100.

<b>Schoolwide Strategies:</b> Multi-tiered System of Support to encourage positive behavior; Regular recognition of students who follow the school expectations; School counselors providing individual, small group, and school-wide lessons (as needed); Effective classroom management plans;

<p><b>Science Goal:</b> By the end of the year, the average of fourth and fifth grade students maintaining or increasing to a basic or above will increase from 71% to 76%.</p> <p><b>Social Studies Goal:</b> By the end of the year, the average of fourth and fifth grade students maintaining or increasing to a basic or above will increase from 55% to 60%.</p>
